- ❑ Our mission is to **improve the transportation system by anticipating emerging issues and advancing technical, operational, and institutional innovations**.

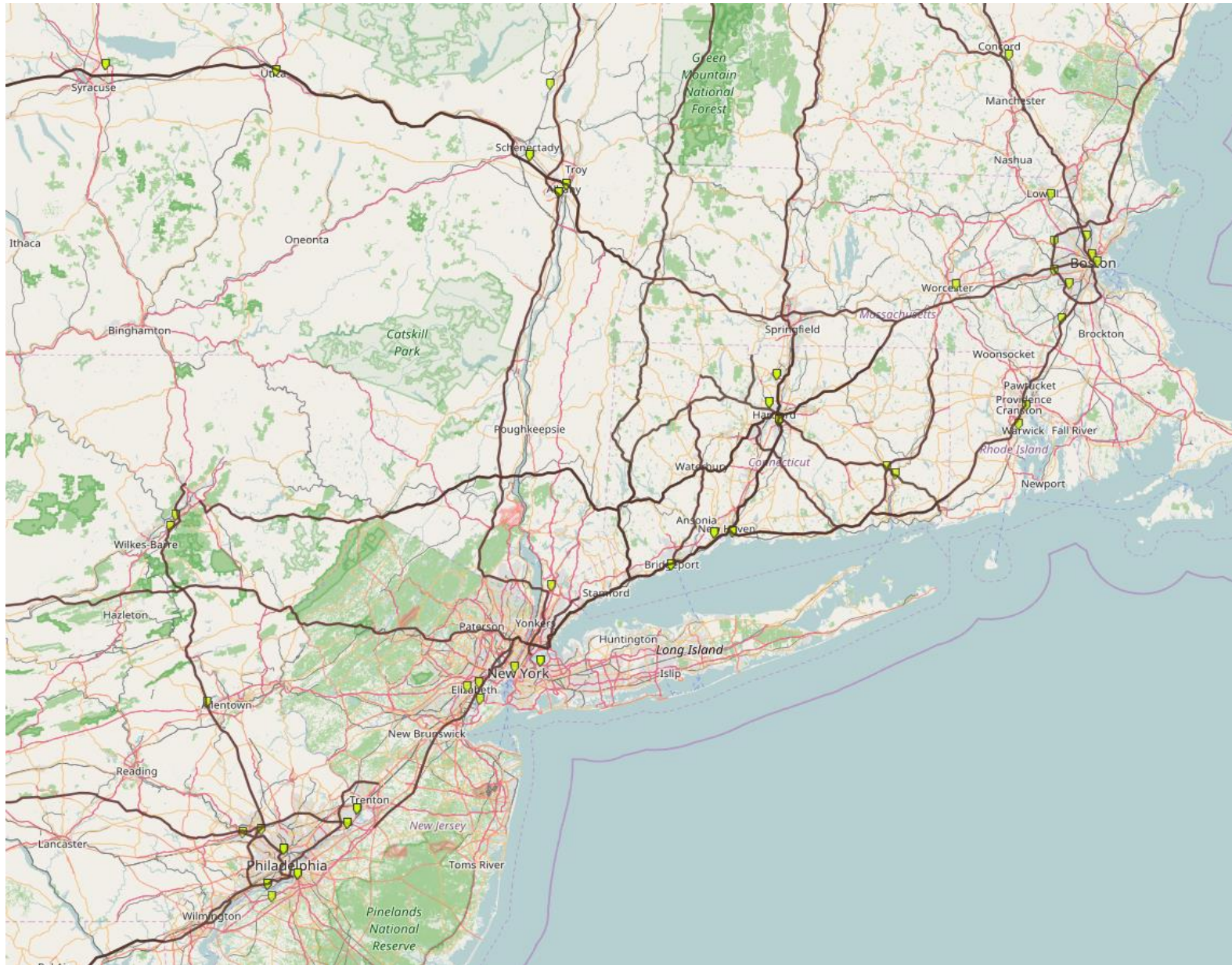
- ❑ We focus on making our **transportation system safer and more efficient, increasing mobility and minimizing the impact on our environment**.

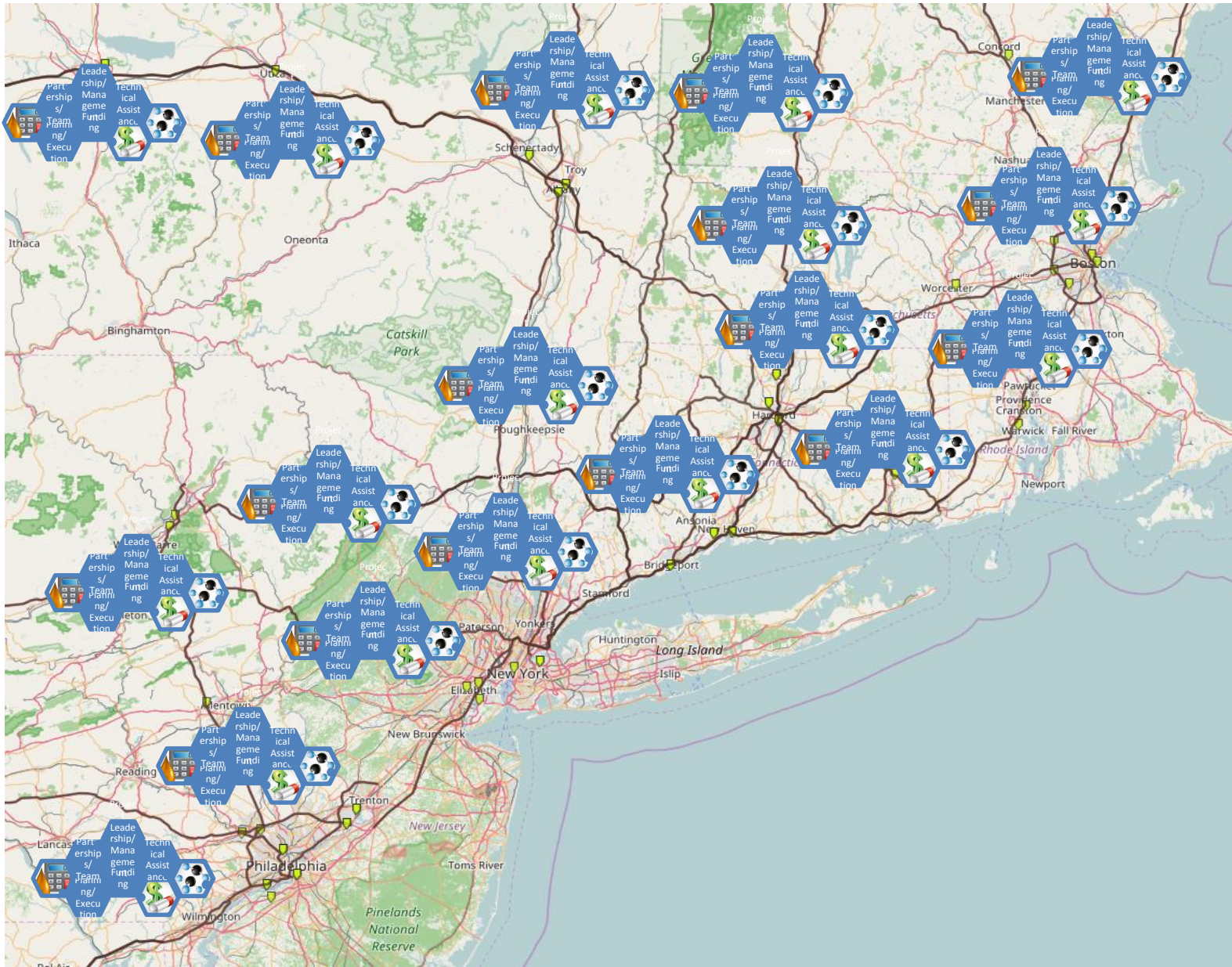
