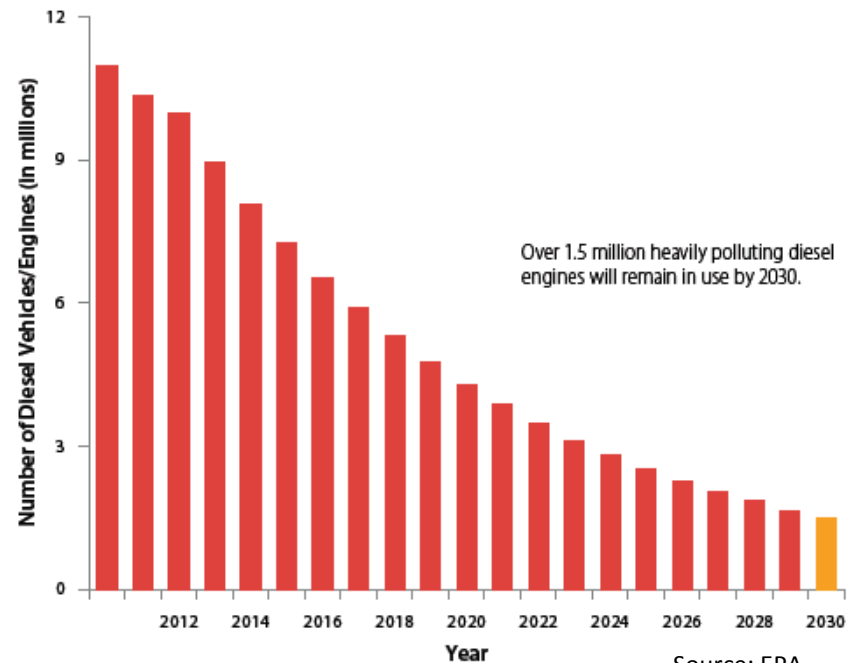

Why Continue?

- EPA estimates that over 11M older diesel engines “legacy fleet” still in use
- ROI— \$1 invested = \$7-\$18 in public health benefits
- Health Effects of Diesel Pollution
 - Aggravated respiratory conditions such as asthma and bronchitis
 - PM is a known carcinogen
 - Responsible for premature deaths
